- ❖ This workshop will NOT be a frontal lecture, rather it will be an interactive study of chapters 19 through 24 in Sefer Shemot, focusing on the skills of how to identify 'units' when studying Chumash, and how to uncover their thematic importance. During the three hour seminar, there will be several 'guided' 10-15 minute assignments (serving also as coffee breaks), that will focus on the skills of analyzing large sections of text. By the time we finish our 'textual journey' we hope to arrive at a much deeper appreciation of the events that transpired at Maamad Har Sinai, and how they apply to our daily lives.

Shiur and discussion
 - Third Class (12:10 p.m. – 1:00 p.m.):
Third assignment - analyzing large units of text in Shemot 21-23
Shiur and discussion
